- Modern telecommunications and transport infrastructure: Reliable fibre-optic network, Wi-Fi and high-speed 4G data services
- International airport offering direct daily flights to major cities across North America and Europe
- Modern, reliable and stable electric supply
- Nearshore location to North America and similar time zone as the US East Coast


- Dedicated operating facilities available in business parks at competitive rates
- A long history of political and social stability
- Welcoming investment environment: The process to start a business is straightforward and is complemented by transparent policies and regulations. There are no restrictions on the ownership of property and no minimum capital requirement
- Quality of lifestyle: Barbados boasts a highly developed standard of living, which makes it an attractive place to live, work and enjoy
- Barbados is committed to diversity in all its forms and cooperates with countries around the world.

Other Incentives

Competitive tax rates: Companies operating in Barbados benefit from a maximum tax rate of 5.5% on taxable income.

Foreign Currency Permit: Entities that earn 100% of their income in foreign currency, are entitled to receive a Foreign Currency Permit. Holders of a Foreign Currency Permit benefit from:

- Exemption from exchange control
- Exemption from property transfer taxes on transfers of shares or quotas
- Income tax concessions for specially qualified individuals as employees



Typical Costs for Setting Up a BPO Company

The typical costs related to setting up a BPO company in Barbados are as follows:

Steps to Setting up ICT Entity	Cost (US\$)
Government - Incorporation fees	Approximately \$400
Foreign Currency Permit application fee	\$125
Foreign Currency Permit fee (on approval of application)	\$500
Annual Foreign Currency Permit renewal fee	\$500
Professional Service Provider Fees - Incorporation	\$1,500 – 3,000

Typical Costs for Operating a BPO Company

Barbados' BPO sector offers competitive operating costs and the following should be taken into consideration:

Direct Labor	Cost (US\$) Per Hour
Data Entry Operator (trainee)	4.25 - 5.00
Data Entry Operator (skilled)	4.50 - 6.00
Customer Service Representative	6.00 - 12.00
Insurance Claims Processor	6.00 - 9.00
Supervisor	7.50 – 17.00

Typical Costs for Operating a BPO Company

Indirect Labor	Cost (US\$) Per Month
Manager	1,500 - 3,000
General Manager	3,500 - 5,000
Systems Analyst/Programmer	1,300 - 5,000
Executive Secretary	1,000 - 2,000
Clerk	1,000 - 1,500
Receptionist	750 - 1,000

NB: National Insurance Contributions (Social Security Contributions), as well as pay for vacation and public holidays are additional costs.

Facility Costs (Government Owned)	Cost (US\$)
Operating Space	13 -15 per sq. ft. per annum
Building insurance & taxes	No Cost
Heating	No Cost
Air Conditioning	4.15 per sq. ft. per annum
